OLD SACRAMENTO **HISTORY**


Historic Old Sacramento dates back to 1848 when the discovery of gold attracted prospectors and entrepreneurs in search of adventure and riches on the riverfront. Old Sacramento was the last stop on the Pony Express

route, the terminus of the transcontinental railroad and housed the original California Supreme Court Chambers.

Today, the area's history is a rich backdrop for exploring all that Old Sacramento has to offer, from dining and shopping to entertainment and culture. Encompassing 28 accessible acres and home to 53 historic buildings, Old Sacramento is the perfect place to explore hidden alleyway gems and underground secrets. St. Patrick's Day Parade & Festival


Families can celebrate all day long at our fun Celtic festival featuring Irish music, dancing, vendors, food and a green
